

Biography of Joseph Lento

During law school, Mr. Lento focused on trial advocacy and trained with nationally recognized criminal defense attorneys and the Defender Association of Philadelphia. Those experiences gave him practical insight into how cases are investigated, challenged, and won.

Before choosing law, Mr. Lento attended the United States Marine Corps Officer Candidates School, which laid the foundation for his hard-driving approach and reinforced the standards he later brought into his legal career.

Building a Practice with a Clear Purpose

After completing his education, Mr. Lento became known for taking on demanding cases, giving clients direct guidance, and getting results. Cutting his teeth in rough and tumble criminal justice courtrooms showed him how difficult it can be for individuals to navigate systems built around institutional priorities rather than fairness.
