


Biography of Matthew Bissell

Being a true student athlete was a tremendous experience because it taught him how to push through mental barriers, in addition to prioritize a very busy schedule.

In the same year, Matthew spent a semester abroad at the University of Sussex in Brighton, England. During this time, he traveled through Europe, Africa, and Asia, visiting countries such as Spain, Morocco, Italy, Greece, Turkey, Romania, Germany, and the Netherlands. During this time he was able to experience a wealth of cultures, and exposed to many different ways of thinking. Completing his undergraduate studies, Matthew pursued additional academic qualifications at Saint Mary's College in Moraga, California.

Early Career Experiences

Matthew's career has been marked by a wide range of professional experiences across multiple industries. His early work included roles in apparel sales, which provided foundational experience in customer service and business operations.
