Bridging Business and Community

Aakash launched his consulting company in 2012 with the intention of helping businesses strengthen their community relationships and navigate local opportunities. Since then, he has worked with more than 350 organizations seeking to build trust and expand their reach. His early professional experience includes time spent in a state capital newsroom, where he learned the value of transparent information sharing, and later in a public relations role for a waterfront hotel and restaurant. These roles helped shape his ability to connect with people and understand the needs of diverse audiences.

Contributions to Education and the Workforce

Patel has dedicated much of his public service to education and workforce development. In 2021, he was appointed by the governor to a four-year term on the district board of trustees for a community college, allowing him to work alongside other leaders to support student access, program quality, and long-term academic success. Since 2014, he has also served as chairman of the early learning coalition in his county, helping guide initiatives that improve early childhood education, encourage school readiness, and provide families with resources that strengthen their children's future potential.

Public Engagement and Media Representation

Aakash Patel has participated in leadership programs and community-focused academies that deepen understanding of local government, public safety, and civic responsibility. Through involvement in regional leadership groups and programs connected to homeland security and federal investigative agencies, he has gained insight into how different parts of the public sector function. With a background in journalism and public affairs, he has written opinion essays for well-known publications and appeared on regional public affairs programs to discuss local issues, aiming always to communicate respectfully and encourage constructive community dialogue.

Recognition and Accolades

Aakash has been recognized for his contributions to business development, leadership growth, and civic engagement. In 2013, he was honored by his university with a place on its "Thirty Under 30" list, acknowledging his accomplishments after earning degrees in political science and English literature.
