Biography

Norwegian-born Unni Turrettini is a speaker and Human Connection Expert who helps people connect with their source of power so they can feel confident and excited about their life.

She is also the author of *Betraying the Nobel: The Secrets and Corruption behind the Nobel Peace Prize* and the award-winning, *The Mystery of the Lone Wolf Killer*, which examines Norwegian mass murderer Anders Behring Breivik from both a psychological and sociological perspective and focuses on what we can learn from that tragedy to prevent rampage killings spurred by loneliness.
