


Health Equality means each individual or group of people is given the same resources or opportunities





Health Equity
recognizes that each person has different circumstances and allocates the exact resources and opportunities needed to reach an equal outcome





Equity → **Meeting people where they are**



Social Determinants of Health (SDOH)

It's the conditions and the environments where people are born, live, learn, work, play, worship, and age that affect a wide range of health, functioning, and quality-of-life outcomes and risks.





Five Group Domains of Social Determinants of Health (SDOH)

1. Economic Stability
2. Education Access and Quality
3. Health Care Access and Quality
4. Neighborhood and Built Environment
5. Social and Community Context
