

Steven Binetter: A Proven Leader in Investment Strategy and Capital Management

Eureka Fund: Innovating in Global Industrials

One of Binetter's most significant achievements at Marshall Wace was the creation and management of the Global Industrials strategy, known internally as the Eureka Fund. The fund was launched with an initial market value of \$200 million and rapidly grew to \$1.5 billion within the first year. By 2017, the Eureka Fund had become a cornerstone of Marshall Wace's portfolio, managing assets between \$3 billion and \$7 billion until 2025. The fund's success was driven by its strategic geographic exposure, with 75% of the fund's assets allocated to U.S. markets and 25% invested internationally.

[Binetter](#) built and led a seven-person investment team known for its stability, exceptional cohesion, and long tenure. This continuity fostered deep institutional knowledge and helped refine the investment process. Under his leadership, the Eureka Fund integrated "quantamental" strategies, which combined traditional fundamental analysis with quantitative techniques, enhancing alpha generation and optimizing risk management across the portfolio.

Expanding Investment Horizons: Private Markets and Digital Finance

In addition to his hedge fund work, Binetter expanded his focus to private market investments during the latter part of his time at Marshall Wace. From 2021 to 2025, he co-managed the MW XO Digital Finance Fund, a private investment vehicle specializing in digital finance and fintech companies. With \$450 million in assets, the fund targeted emerging opportunities in the intersection of finance and technology.

Binetter's role in sourcing, analyzing, and managing over half of the fund's capital was critical to its success. Key investments included stakes in leading digital finance companies such as Circle, Human Interest, Lukka, TRM Labs, and Accelerant—companies that are reshaping financial infrastructure, compliance frameworks, data analytics, and insurance systems for institutional clients. His focus on the digital finance space helped position him as a thought leader and strategic investor in an industry experiencing rapid transformation.

A Solid Foundation at Eminence Capital

Before his time at Marshall Wace, Binetter gained invaluable experience at Eminence Capital, a \$7 billion long/short equity hedge fund in New York. Joining the firm in 2007, he quickly advanced from Research Associate to Portfolio Manager. In this role, he managed a diverse portfolio of up to 25 concurrent positions across various sectors, including industrials, technology, media, telecommunications, and consumer goods. Binetter's responsibilities spanned Western Europe, South America, and Asia, which broadened his global perspective and deepened his expertise in international markets.

Binetter's success at Eminence was driven by his rigorous fundamental research and disciplined investment execution, which formed the foundation for his subsequent leadership roles in the investment industry.
