PARSP



The **Professional Asset Recovery Standards Program** establishes the ethical, investigative, and professional framework for Asset Recovery Professionals. This course is designed to elevate Asset Recovery practice through standards-based education, emphasizing ethics, investigative discipline, legal boundaries, and public-trust responsibility in surplus and unclaimed property recovery.

Course Purpose and Scope

The purpose of this program is to establish professional standards for Asset Recovery Professionals operating in surplus and unclaimed property recovery.

- ▶ Ethical obligations in post-loss environments
- ▶ Ethical Recovery firm management
- ▶ Investigative methodology and documentation standards

- ▶ Public-trust responsibilities and policy awareness
